

Eurolink is an international joint venture. Its objectives are the design and construction of the Messina's Strait Bridge in Italy.

The project includes the 3300m main bridge span and all road and rail accesses. Scheduled completion time is close to 7 years and total construction budget is close to 6.000.000.000€.

IMPREGILO (45,00 %): the leading company of the JV. Listed on the Italian Stock Exchange, Impregilo group is a world leading construction company and a major player in the realization of large infrastructure works, architecturally relevant buildings, in the infrastructure management sector with a wide range of activities from urban and extra-urban motorways, energy production from renewable sources, as well as systems and environmental engineering sector (desalination and waste to-energy).

In operation since 1906, today Impregilo is present with its projects and works in more than 30 countries worldwide. Total Group revenues in 2010 totaled € 2,062 million with a total order book of € 23 billion.





**SACYR S.A. (18,70 %):** founded in 1986, as the core of a complete infrastructure group created through continuous growth, mergers and acquisitions.

After 24 years in the field, Sacyr Vallehermoso group is listed on the IBEX in Madrid and Euronext in Lisbon. The group is well integrated and diversified and covers a wide range of construction projects, real estate, infrastructure and services.

Total company revenues in 2010 were € 4,820 million and total order book € 51,531. The group operates worldwide, 72 % of the portfolio consists of international business.
